Location

Fukuoka is a city of contrasts that offers a cosmopolitan urban environment and beautiful natural scenery, a place where history and traditional culture entwine with contemporary society and global aspirations. The city is compact and easy to explore, with beaches and mountains easily accessible from the department stores of downtown Fukuoka and the shrines and temples of Hakata Old Town.

The Kyushu Grand Sumo Tournament is held every fall in Fukuoka. The Kyushu tournament began in 1957, upgraded to a formal tournament from what had been an exhibition tour. Since 1981, it has been held in Fukuoka Kokusai Center. Many jungyo beya (places where wrestlers sleep and practice) are set up around various parts of the city during the tournament. You may happen to come across a sumo wrestler during the conference.







Venue

The Kyushu University School of Medicine Centennial Hall is located in the south of the hospital campus, overlooking the 75th Anniversary Memorial Garden.

In 2003, the Kyushu University School of Medicine reached its 100th year since its inauguration as Kyoto Imperial University Fukuoka Medical College in 1903.

To celebrate the 100th anniversary, the School of Medicine Centennial Anniversary Memorial Project Support Club was formed by the School of Medicine alumni association and the professorate. The Kyushu University School of Medicine Centennial Hall was built and donated to the university by the Anniversary Project Support Club as the most important part of the anniversary project.


